Mess Hali for breakfast by A.42212 Jpl. Carnegie N.C.O. i/c Regimental Folice. At the end of the meal Pts. McWilliams and I escorted the three prisoners out of the mess hall to wash their mess tins. Pye had finished cleaning their mess tins I saw them leave the ablution bench and disappear around the corner of the kitchen escorted by Pte. No 45 Gdn Gen Tpt Coy RCASC The accused declines to cross examine the witness. SECOND WITHESS M.65177 Pte. J.A. McWILLIAMS of the No 45 Cdn Gen Tpt Coy RCASC having been duly called and sworn states; "I am M.65177 Pte. J.A. McWILLIAMS one of the regimental police of the No 45 Cdn Jen Tpt Coy RCA3C. As such I was responsible along with the other members of the regimental police of this unit, for the custody of the accused L.8794 Private Lawrence Michael Power whom I now recognize, and who was on the 24 May 43 undergoing sentence of detention in the unit lines before being committed to Headley Downs Detention Barracks. At approximately 0710 hrs on 24 May 43 having finished meal together with A.44558 Pte. Gibson of theregimental police I escorted three prisoners Pte. Power Pte. Pye and C.52357 Pte. Copp to the ablution tables to clean their mess tins. When Pte. Power and Pte. Pye had finished, they proceeded back to the Guard Room and I followed at a distance of eight feet. They went aroung the end of the mess hall and endeavouring to catch up with them there I found that they were nowhere to be seen, the time was approximately 0715 hrs. I looked for them but was unable to find them and reported immediately to A.42212 Cpl. Carnegie, S.M., E.C.C. 1/c Regimental Police.
