times and places determined by the Association or its officers, and may be convened upon the call of the President or any other two officers.

ARTICLE 5.—OFFICERS

Section 1. The officers shell consist of an Hon. President, a President, a First Vice-President, a second Vice-President, an Executive Committee, and a Secretary-Treasurer.

Section 2. The officers shall serve for one year, or until their successors are elected, with exception of the Secretary-Treasurer (known as Permanent Secretary), who shall remain in office until removed by action of the Executive Committee.

Section 3. Vacancies from any cause may be filled by the officers at any meeting.

Section 4. The duties of these officers may at any time be prescribed by formal action of the Convention. In the absence of such action their duties shall be those implied by their designation and established by custom.

ARTICLE 6.-MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. The basis of representation shall be as follows:

The Lieutenant-Governors of the Province of British Columbia, Saskstchewan and Alberta.

All members of the Dominion Parliament.

All members of the Legislative Assemblies of the Province of British Columbia, Saskatchewan and Alberta.
