SUGGESTIONS FOR MARCH.—Examine land and note the fields needing draining. Care should be exercised in preparing and cleaning seeds for spring planting, selecting only the best and plumpest of each kind for such purpose.

Farming Implements.-Tools may be examined, harness offed, etc.

Let all your preparations for spring work be marching on to completion. Remember that a few acres of early peas will amply repay for the trouble of preparation, besides leaving the ground in good condition; and when the proper time arrives to sow, have a good spot ready for them. They furnish excellent food for stock or pigs raising litters, as they produce an abundant flow of milk. Decide what crop is best for a given piece of land, and sow that particular one thereon if possible.
