SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTHWEST LAND REGULATIONS.

THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta.

Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years.

A settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre.

German Fleet Failed in Its Initiative

German fleet failed in its initiative. Twelve years almost to a day before the declaration of war, the Kaiser flung to the world his vaunting signal, "The Admiral of the Atlantic greets the Admiral of the Pacific."

The chances were unpropitious in the first stage of the war. It has always been an axiom of the German fleet that the true plan of campaign was to cripple or to reduce seriously the strength of the British fleet at the outbreak of the war.

Why Plan Failed. The plan failed because Britain scented the coming of war, and, contrary to all historical precedent, was prepared for war.
