COUNTERFEIT COINS.

SIMPLE RULES BY WHICH THEY MAY BE DETECTED.

Tests Which Are Used by the Experts in the Treasury Department, Who Never Fail to Recognize the Spurious Article.

"It is not always easy to detect counterfeit gold and silver coins," says the director of the mint, "especially where they are of good weight and extra fine finish and the peculiar slippery surface by which many counterfeiters may be detected is absent."

"The public, in their haste in the exchange of money, should find time to scrutinize with care each coin as it is handled. There is always much counterfeit coin in circulation."

"One presses at the mint are extremely heavy, weighing 13.00 grammes. Naturally a piece of gold or silver struck from their dies is as nearly perfect as it is possible to make a coin. Yet counterfeiters, with their light presses and dies, manage to do some very clever work. The product of molds, a favorite method with the smaller fry of counterfeiters, is inferior to that of the dies. The absence of the clear cut appearance of the genuine coin, the defective weight, the imperfect lettering and milling and the indistinct reading on the outer edge of the coin are the distinguishing characteristics which will guide the public in detecting coins thus made. Italians are the greatest offenders against the law with mold-made counterfeiters. The most expert turners out of metal counterfeiters have been regular makers of dies who wanted to get rich quickly."

"The standard of gold made by our mints is 900 fine, or 21.10 carats. A new \$20 counterfeit is probably a composition of gold, copper and silver, the gold being of low grade. The facinades are often quite perfect, with a clear ring and sharp, well appearing lettering and milling, being well calculated to deceive those who are not used to the handling of coins."

"Platinum is a metal which gives the required weight and is extensively used in gold counterfeiting. Clear cut coins are made from this metal and heavily gold plated. They are comparatively easily passed, especially when first put into circulation. After a time the plating wears off about the edges and its spurious base is revealed. Lead, type metal, zinc and antimony are the metals principally used for silver counterfeiting, and copper, brass, silver and platinum for gold imitations. Counterfeits of lead and type metal are easily detected and are passed on ignorant persons or foreigners."

"Antimony and lead are the component parts of the most dangerous counterfeiters of silver coins, the antimony furnishing the bulk of the coin. When struck from good dies, with a heavy plating of silver, they give forth a good ring and present a pretty fair substitute for the genuine article. The dollar is the denomination most counterfeited."

"Counterfeit gold coins may be executed with such much precision that they will pass muster under the eyes of bank tellers and others used to the handling of coins, though the average teller generally detects a spurious coin on sight. But none gets by the test of the mint. They fail the result of years of study and handling of coins, in detecting a counterfeit is marvelous. They seem to know a spurious coin by instinct, though it is really the result of training. Yet even these men, as skillful as they are, occasionally have doubts, raised in their minds as to whether a coin is genuine or not. If suspicious, the coin is cut in half, or it is assayed here in the building and its exact weight and fineness determined."

"Coins are now and then turned into the treasury upon the supposition that they are counterfeit, because they fail to give the peculiar clear ring of a genuine goldpiece, though they present otherwise the appearance of being genuine."

"This singular incongruity is accounted for by the fact that the coin is a small hollow shell the interior of the metal or the flaw consists of a crack or split near the edge. Experts know where to look for these imperfections imperceptible to others and with power of magnifying glass they quickly made manifest."

"If the public will remember three cardinal points in determining the spuriousness of the genuine and which are used by the treasury experts, it will be a difficult matter to pass off counterfeit upon one who is accustomed to handling money. We call them the test of 'weight, diameter and thickness.'"

"It has been demonstrated that counterfeiters do not combine the three requisites with spurious metals. Bear this test in mind, note carefully the weight, ring, size, impress, milling and reading, all of which require may be taken in with a glance, and you will always carry about with him a pretty good 'detector.'"

"The men who make it their business to cheat the government out of gold adopt several processes. I saw a coin recently which had been 'filled' so cleverly that the fraud was apparent only upon the closest examination. The \$10 and \$20 pieces are mostly used for this operation. The coin was sawed through from the edge by a saw of minute proportions and exquisite fineness, the interior removed and the cavity filled with platinum which brought the piece up to standard weight, though it lost three-quarters of its value. It gave forth a good ring. If it had been filled with a base metal other than platinum, it would have lacked the ring and been of light weight."

"In some of these filled coins the exterior walls of gold are as thin as ordinary writing paper. Once the cavity is filled the sides are clamped into the original position and brazed together. The edges are skillfully recovered with gold, the reading, or the minute markings on the edges, restored and the coin will pass readily in the hands of the unscrupulous."

"The most dangerous tampered coins are those which have been 'plugged.' This means plugging the word is ordinarily accepted and as we see every day in the silver coins, but where the skillful counterfeiters get out as high as one-sixth of the weight of a \$10 or \$20 piece. The coin is pierced by being a fine needle in the edge and the gold extracted from this diminutive aperture. It is then plugged with platinum, the surface of the aperture covered with genuine metal and the reading restored with a file. Much as the coins are genuine and the minute hole in the edge so adroitly covered these tampered with pieces pass from hand to hand until the gold on the edge wears off and the deception becomes apparent."

Blige Water.

I am quite well aware that there are objections to hospital ships in the tropics. When they are moved, there is the burning question of bilge water. I will not discuss on the subject of bilge water, as inexperience thereof might make the explanation wearisome. Any one acquainted with the bilge water question knows it is of enormous interest. Bilge is a prince among smells, and if you have ever fallen under its power you will always think that every terrific thing in smells is a manifestation of bilge water."

I remember on one occasion when on board a moored bulk, not a hospital ship, smelling in the evening so I mentioned it. "Oh," said my companions, more under the sway of bilge water than I was, from their greater knowledge of its power, "it's only our bilge water." In the morning we found it was the rotting carcass of an elephant that had floated down the river and now hung in the morning chain."

After a considerable time was spent in getting rid of the carcass I said, "For goodness' sake, gentlemen, stir up your bilge water, and let the smells fight it out together while we go ashore for a spell." "No," said my companions, terror-stricken at the suggestion. "You do not know our bilge water when it's back up. It would stretch you if you were half way across Asia. This elephant is mere lavender water to it."

This was a more dreadful bilge water than a hospital ship would have. Still, though bad, bilge water is not necessarily fatal under proper management."

A Historic Die.

On the desk of the secretary of one of the oldest copper manufacturing firms in this city is a steel die which has served as a paperweight for 35 years, and the coins struck off by it are now, for the most part, in the hands of collectors. This die was used for striking copper tokens which symbolized the contest between President Andrew Jackson and the old United States Bank of Philadelphia in 1832. The engraving on the die represents President Jackson, sword in hand and apparently standing in a money chest. Around the central figure is stamped Jackson's expression, "I take the responsibility," which arose out of his controversies with the bank."

When this die was made, the predecessors of the present company not only manufactured copper wire, but also made a special feature of copper coins, chiefly for South American countries and for private business firms which made a practice of issuing their own copper coins to be redeemed by them afterward. During the civil war and just preceding it many private corporations issued tokens which circulated as pennies, and some of them are now worth a great many times their original value to collectors."

Still in the remotest trading posts of the fur traders a few fine specimens remain."

ORCHARD AND GARDEN.

One advantage in early budding is that a better opportunity is given to repent.

If the condition of the soil will admit, now is a good time to set out strawberry plants.

This is the season for evaporating and preserving fruit for winter. Make sure of a full supply.
