The creditors of H. Hutchinson & Son, Alliston, met at Henry Barber & Co's office yesterday. No satisfactory offer was made and the stock of goods is to be sold.

The meeting of creditors of the estate of James Eaton & Co. will be held on Friday afternoon in Assignee Campbell's office.

The creditors of Stevens & Burns, agricultural implements, London, met in that city on Tuesday. The statement of liabilities of \$180,000, leaving a nominal credit balance of \$80,000. The assets consist of customers' deposits to the amount of \$130,000 or over, of which \$120,000 is held between the Union Bank of Winnipeg, the Bank of British North America and the Bank of Commerce, nearly half of which is now past due.

The statement was discussed at some length and finally it was resolved to adjourn the meeting two weeks in order to give the firm an opportunity to arrange some of the more doubtful debts.
