AGREE TO TRIAL OF NEW SCHEDULE

Street Railway Company and Men Come To Terms FOR ABOUT TWO WEEKS Men Objected To "Swing Runs" Necessitated

An agreement to give the new schedule a trial of about two weeks was effected at a conference of the executive committee of the union with Manager Kings and Supt. Humeaton of the London Street Railway Company, yesterday afternoon.

The men do not approve of the action of the company in introducing "swing runs" in such a manner that the motor-men and conductors on those runs cannot complete their day of nine or nine and one-half hours in less than 14 hours or so.

The aim of the general technical, home and preparatory courses of the school is to provide a general academic education equal to that provided by collegiate institutes, combined with a good general training of sufficient variety to enable students to intelligently select an occupation; to develop the students' intelligence and so prepare boys for the direct positions in the industrial world and girls for the home making activities and occupations for which girls require special training, and both for intelligent citizenship.

The Technical High School course is a three-year high school course to provide boys with a thorough secondary school education, and, at the same time, prepare them for the direct positions in the industries. The course provides a broad, general education together with a special vocational training for boys.

The first two years of the course is devoted to a general course which includes the essential of a good general academic education with a sufficient variety of practical work to afford an opportunity of making an intelligent choice of a vocation for which the boy's aptitudes fit him. The advice of the teachers and of the shop instructors of the school, who are master mechanics with years of practical trade experience and technical training, are given in guiding parents and students in making a selection of a course in which to specialize during the student's third year in the school.

The first year in the school affords an opportunity for students to specialize in one form of practical shop work with the necessary draughting and mathematics. Short-handled typing and bookkeeping are introduced at the beginning of the course. This enables students who are particularly apt in these subjects to regularize their attendance and close application, to secure a Junior diploma at the end of the second year. This will be a passport to stenography and Junior office positions.
