Our zeal burns brightest in contending for orthodox tenets, and a sort of technical language rendered sacred, and of imposing influence, by long prescription. Such as the covenant of works; the covenant of grace; the active and passive obedience of Christ; legal repentance; the terms and conditions of the gospel; the gospel offer; the holy sacraments; ministerial, sacramental, and catholic communion; the meditorial kingdom of Christ; the millennium; historic faith, temporary faith, the faith of devils, the faith of assurance, and the assurance of faith; the direct act of faith, the reflex act of faith; baptismal vows; kirk sessions; fencing the tables; metallic tok ns, &c. &c. Thus to speak in clerical dignity, more than half the language of Ashdod is mingled with less than half the language of Canaan; and the people are generally zealous about such confounding, misleading, and arrogant distinctions, which all result in divesting christian-
