## **CLARK ANNOUNCES WORKING VISIT TO TURKEY, JORDAN AND ISRAEL**

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, today announced that he will be visiting Turkey, Jordan and Israel from November 23 to 25 for a series of one-day discussions with foreign ministers and other senior leaders in those countries.

"These discussions will give me an opportunity to underline Canada's support for maintaining the international consensus on the need for Iraq to withdraw from Kuwait as well as to maintain support for UN sanctions," stated Mr. Clark.

During his working visits, Mr. Clark will also discuss other bilateral and regional issues, including Lebanon and the Arab-Israeli dispute. He will start his visit in Turkey on the 23rd of November, will travel to Jordan on the 24th, and will finish his trip in Israel on November 25.
