Income Tax

Mr. Turner (Ottawa-Carleton): Mr. Chairman, we tabled an amendment, which I should like to move now. The amendment is as follows:

That clause 73 of Bill C-49 be amended

- (a) by striking out line 26 on page 188 and substituting the following: "been paid out of the exempt surplus, as defined by regulation (in this part referred to as exempt surplus) of"
- (b) by striking out line 33 on page 188 and substituting the following: "of the taxable surplus, as defined by regulation (in this part referred to as taxable surplus) of the affiliate"

These two changes makes specific reference to the fact that there are two terms, "exempt surplus" and "taxable surplus". These are terms defined in the regulations under the Income Tax Act but are not terms defined within the act itself. This is merely a technical amendment.

Amendment (Mr. Turner, (Ottawa-Carleton)) agreed to. Clause as amended agreed to.
