

is the munificent one of \$46 "00 a month absolutely inadequate , and it appears difficult to get any action unless we can persuade some one with the right knowledge and influence to lend us their aid , and I therefore appeal to you to use your influence on this man's behalf. The family are so far behind now with rent, etc, and but for the action of friends they would be in a sorry predicament, that action has become imperative. I shall be glad to give you any further information regarding this case if you so desire it, and also ratification of the facts I have here presented. I understand that our local doctor, himself a returned man, will not look into the case because there is very little financial remuneration attached to these cases, so that avenue has been blocked for us.

I feel certain that you will do all that you can to see that this case gets the attention it deserves , and I shall be personally very grateful if you can do something very soon. My view is that this is an appeal for a just and equitable deal from the government for whom he did his bit, nobly and well, and I feel sure that <sup>you</sup> share my view.
