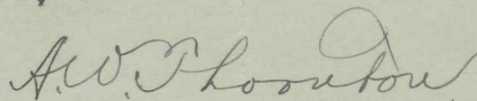
I cannot refrain from offering to you my very hearty thanks for the splendid work, which with your help, we were able to accomplish at the Faculty Meeting held last evening.
