2nd August 1933. Dear Madam: I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 31st July in which you complain that you could not get a job in one of the fraternity houses. I am very sorry that in this I cannot help you in any way. The fraternities do not belong to McGill University, nor have the University authorities anything whatever to say in their administration, who they employ as cook is their own business and I cannot influence their choice in that matter. I am full of sympathy for you, especially as they have employed a foreigner. I would be glad to help you in this matter if I had any authority whatever in connection with fraternity houses.
