

vote, no further debate or remark shall be admitted unless a mistake has been made, in which case the mistake shall be rectified, and the Presiding Officer shall recommence taking the vote.

14. A question may be reconsidered any time for three months, but a motion for reconsideration, being once made and decided in the negative, shall not be received before three months.

15. A motion to reconsider must be made and seconded by members voting in the majority. No question shall be reconsidered more than once, nor shall a vote to reconsider be reconsidered. To reconsider a resolution, &c., the decision of which has officially passed out of the company, shall not be in order.

16. A motion to repeal or rescind a resolution shall be offered in writing and announced at least one week before action shall be taken on the same, and shall only be in order when the motion to reconsider is no longer available.

17. The one first named in the appointment of a committee shall be Chairman of the same, and shall call the committee together at such time and place as he may select; but when thus convened, any committee may elect their own Chairman and Secretary.

18. All reports of committees, except reports of progress shall be made in writing, and signed by a majority.

19. When a report has been read, it shall be considered a properly before the meeting, without a motion to accept.
