PROVINCE'S INDUSTRIES ARE IDE AT GUELPH

Result of Making Hospital and Vocational Training Centre Out of Guelph Reformatory Has Been to Close Abattoir, Quarry and Woolen Mill That Were Run by Province Under Late Mr. Hanna.

Special to The Toronto World. Guelph, Dec. 21.—Ontario ministers who have been lately looking into matters in which provincial undertakings have been affected by Dominion administration are known to have returned to Toronto with the idea that the time is approaching when some revision of the arrangements may be anticipated. The Hon. Mr. Doherty has inspected the provincial abattoir, which it was once thought might have afforded a valuable example to Toronto as to how to make the municipal abattoir a success, but which has for some time been closed. The abattoir was built under the late Mr. Hanna's regime as provincial secretary, during which his chief executive lieutenant was Mr. Sam Armstrong, now in Chicago.

Abattoir Saved Money. Mr. Armstrong brought about a revolution in the feeding methods of the provincial prisons and hospitals for the insane, which saved the province scores of thousands of dollars a year in costs of supplies. This was done by rendering more uniform the dietary methods of the various institutions, under expert supervision and somewhat along the lines that have been adopted during the last two years at the Toronto General Hospital.

VACCINE POINT STILL HOLDS SWAY

Quarantine Regulations in Border Counties Remain Tight.

Special to The Toronto World. Bridgeburg, Ont., Dec. 20.—Instead of being lifted as intended, the quarantine regulations in effect along the United States border are tighter at the present time than they have been previously.

This week saw the passport regulations that had been arranged for the convenience of border-residents and commuters withdrawn, and it is now necessary for every person living on this side of the river who desires to enter the States to become vaccinated. The common expression when a citizen meets a citizen along the frontier now is: "How is your vaccination?" The whole frontier practically, even to little children, has had to submit to the vaccine point, or stay away from Buffalo, Ontario.
