SCHOOL HYGIENE CONGRESS.
 Local Committee Organized to Participate in World's Conference.

The second international congress on school hygiene will be held in London in August, 1907. The first congress was held in Nuremberg in 1904. Sir Lauder Brunton, who visited Toronto last summer, having asked that a committee for Ontario be organized, a meeting was called in the senate chamber of the university, which was attended by Dr. R. A. Reeve, Dr. McPhedran, Inspector Hughes, W. H. Shaw, Principal Scott, Principal Auden, Rev. J. Macdonald, Dr. Oldright and Dr. Helen MacMurchy. Dr. Oldright was appointed chairman and Dr. MacMurchy secretary. A local committee was organized, with Hon. R. A. Ryne as honorary president. Dr. Oldright chairman and Inspector Hughes secretary, and an executive committee consisting of Principal Auden, Principal Scott, Dr. McPhedran, Dr. MacMurchy and W. H. Shaw.
