## EUROPE THREATENS RETALIATION

It does not happen very often that Canada has anything in common politically with the countries of the continent, but at the present time we can make common cause with them in opposing the trade aggression of the United States. Experts have been figuring up the aggregate trade between the continent of Europe and the United States, and they find that in 1890 the United States imported from Europe \$600,000,000, while its exports to Europe were only \$353,884,000. In 1900 the amount was \$1,040,000,000, against \$440,000,000. In other words, the United States exports to Europe between two and three times as much as it imports. It is this unfavorable trade balance that is causing such alarm in Europe. Discussing the question in this week's issue of the New York Independent, Paul Leroy-Beaulieu, one of the most eminent economists of the continent, remarks: "The situation can be considered normal, permanent or decisive. Commerce means exchange, and exchange means an approximate equality of values between merchandise bought and sold. If the United States wishes to assure the uninterrupted development of its European trade, it must buy more from Europe. Otherwise the situation will become impossible. Europe cannot be reduced to a subordinate position, a vassalage, to the United States."

## DANA AS AN ANARCHIST

The Buffalo Courier, commenting on The New York Sun's denunciation of anarchism, makes the statement that the late editor of the latter paper, Charles A. Dana, was at one time an ardent believer in the doctrines of Prudhomme, French anarchist. Dana is not an anarchist or not, but the probabilities are that he was. What we do know about Mr. Dana is that he was intensely anti-British, and he was in a large measure responsible for the bad feeling that for so many years kept the United States and Great Britain at arm's length. Anglo-Saxon unity has been immensely helped by the death of the late editor of The Sun. The incendiary racial appeals of Dana would not be tolerated under the regime of William Brewster, he did ten times as much for the United States as he did for Canada, and he was a fortunate day for Anglo-Saxon unity.
