Negotiations for what is undoubtedly the largest milling consolidation that has ever been effected in Ontario have just been completed.

The new company has taken over the properties of the Hedley Shaw Milling Company, Limited, and the Maple Leaf Flour Mills Company, Limited, and in addition secures from the new interests that have been identified with the company \$1,000,000, additional cash.

The preferred stock will, therefore, be a floating charge on the assets of the company, and it is expected that the new company will be able to pay dividends.

FRESH RUBY DISCOVERIES

Engineer McMaster Says Prospects Are Rushing into Ashby Township.

The recent announcement that rich ruby corundum veins had been discovered in Ashby Township, Ashby County of Addition, and the fact that the properties are being developed by a strong company known as Ruby, Ltd., has caused a rush of prospectors into the district.

The prospectors who have been coming into the district are being organized by Mr. Harry McMaster, mining engineer for Ruby, Ltd., who has just returned from a further inspection of the company's claims.

Three adjoining claims on which the prospectors have been made have been staked. The formation is the same as that of the ruby gem.
