# RUSSIAN WOLVES COMMON ENEMY

During Winter Russian and

# NERVE-SKIN-BLIND

**German Soldiers Forced to Fight Them.**

In the course of last winter's campaign the wolves of the Polish and Baltic Russian stretches had amassed such numbers in the Kovno-Wilna-Linsk district as to become a veritable plague to both Russian and German soldiers. So persistent were the half-starved beasts in their attacks on small groups of soldiers that they became a serious menace even to fighting men in the trenches. Poison, rifle fire, hand grenades, and even machine guns were successively tried in attempts to eradicate the nuisance. But all to no avail: The wolves—nowhere to be found quite so large and powerful as in Russia—were desperate in their hunger and regard for their own lives. They would appear in place of those that were killed by the Russian and German troops.

As a last resort, the two adversaries, with the consent of their commanders, entered into negotiations for an armistice and joined forces to hunt down the wolves. For the first time there was peace. And in no haz-
