Of the wheat entered as exported to the United States for consumption it was that country over ninety-four per cent. The balance was shipped to the divisions and two-thirds of this from Port Willam and Port Arthur. Some 400,000 bushels crossed the border at British Columbia ports, and nearly all of them came from Lethbridge. From Saskatchewan points, nearly all through North Port, 2,898,922 bushels crossed the border under license. Of this, 1,670,000 bushels were shipped to the United States, the remainder being destined for Great Britain.

The total quantity of wheat which was exported to the United States during the year ending April 30, 1912, was 1,670,000 bushels, the greatest amount ever sent there by Canada. It is probable that this would be wheat grown in Ontario. The Niagara frontier reported 1,670,000 bushels of wheat for the year ending April 30, 1912. Since the bulk of this might have been Ontario wheat it is probable that the bulk of it was western wheat from Port Colborne or from other lake ports.

Some 1,670,000 bushels were exported from points east of Niagara, the

Chernyany, Alta. April 23, 1935. — Seed treated by a new process of seed electrification, a method which is claimed to increase the resistance of seeds to various plant diseases and improve the quality, will be sown this year by many of the leading farmers in Southern Alberta. A plant for the treating of seeds is now being erected at Calgary. Its capacity is taxed to such an extent that an enlargement will be asked immediately.

Great claims are made as to the advantages of this process. It is well known as the Wolfen Electro-Chemical process of seed electrification. The process consists in placing the seed to be treated in a bath containing a soluble calcium salt such as calcium or sodium chloride and weakly electrifying them the same for a length of time appropriate to the seed under treatment. The solution is then dried and the seeds are sown in the soil and dry. The object of the salt is not only to decrease the resistance, or, in other words, to increase the conductivity, of the seed, but also to increase its resistance during the period of germination. Calcium and sodium in correct proportions are, moreover, plant food and assist in the after stimulation of growth.

This method is a new one to Canada, but it has been tried with remarkable success in England. From the reports for the season 1932 of field trials conducted in the Ministry of Agriculture Department of the Board of Agriculture, of farms selected by themselves, the results showed a gain of two to seven bushels of wheat to the acre, 4½ to 19 bushels of oats, and five to sixteen bushels of barley.
