Ernest Robinson, secretary of the Winnipeg Trades and Labor Council, offered to produce a list of names of strikers who had been discriminated against. He said an attempt was being made by employers and the city of Win- nipeg to stamp out trades unionism.

A. F. Landry of Ottawa, organizer of the Canadian Brotherhood of Railway Employees, made a statement of reasons for the strike. He said that the working class could not get sufficient wages for the necessities of life; the government refused action; the employers refused to allow the employees to bargain with them collectively and a general strike was the only alternative left.
