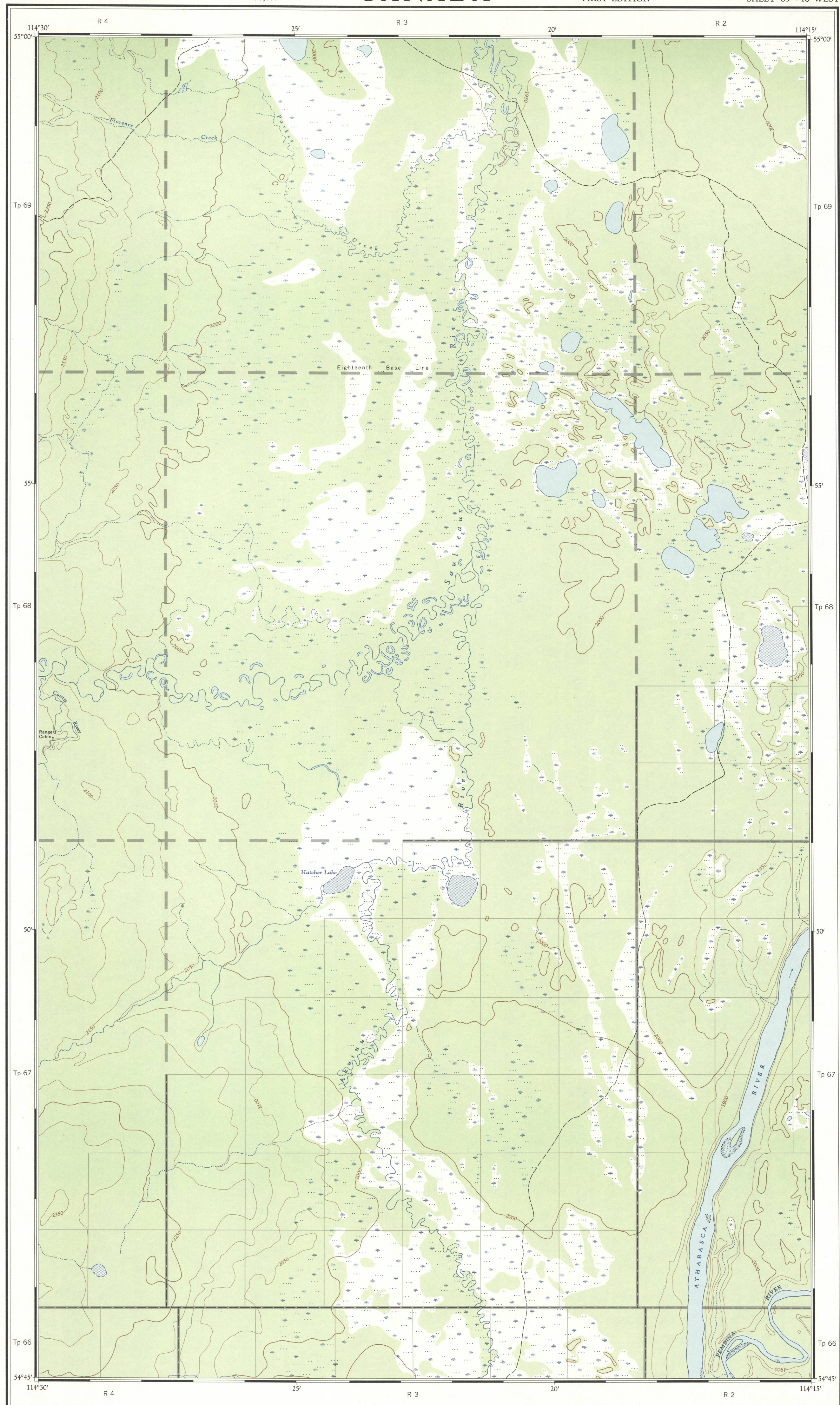


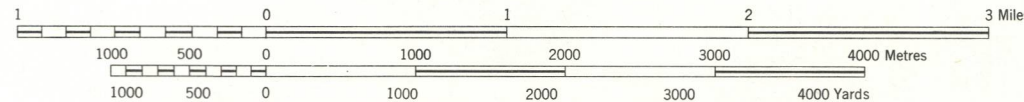


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MAGNETIC DECLINATION 24° 31' EAST AT CENTRE OF MAP 1959 Annual magnetic change 5' 30" westerly
