

On the vote being taken the amendment of Mr. McMullen was carried by a majority, and became the judgment of the Synod.

Mr. Mann craved leave to enter his dissent, and craved extracts.

It was moved by Mr. Straith, seconded by Mr. D. Gordon, and unanimously carried, that the thanks of the Synod be tendered to the minister and office-bearers of Knox Church, St. Catharines, for the excellent accommodations provided; to the Christian citizens for their kind hospitality, and to the railway companies which have granted reduced fares to the members of Synod.

ADJOURNMENT.

The business of the Synod having been concluded, Mr. Straith, at the request of the Moderator, engaged in prayer; after which, and engaging in praise, the Moderator declared the Synod dissolved, to meet at Brantford, and within Zion Church there, on the second Monday of April, eighteen hundred and eighty-one, at half past seven o'clock p. m., and was closed by the Moderator pronouncing the benediction,
