14.

That a Member called to order shall sit down, Member called unless permitted to explain; and the House, if to order appealed to, shall decide on the case, but without debate; if there be no appeal, the decision of the Chair shall be submitted to.

15.

That no Member shall speak disrespectfully of Disrespectful, the Queen or any of the Royal Family, or Person or indecent administering the Government of this Province; language, &c. nor shall he use unmannerly or indecent language against the proceedings of this House, or against particular Members; nor shall he speak beside the question in debate.

16.

That each Member may, of right, require the Members may question or motion in discussion to be read for his demand that the question information at any time of the debate, but not so &c., be read. as to interrupt a Member speaking.
