That a Member called to order shall sit down, ^{Member called to order.} unless permitted to explain; and the House, if appealed to, shall decide on the case, but without debate; if there be no appeal, the decision of the Chair shall be submitted to.

15.

That no Member shall speak disrespectfully of ^{Disrespectful, unmannerly, or indecent language, &c.} the Queen or any of the Royal Family, or Person administering the Government of this Province; nor shall he use unmannerly or indecent language against the proceedings of this House, or against particular Members; nor shall he speak beside the question in debate.

16.

That each Member may, of right, require the ^{Members may demand that the question} question or motion in discussion to be read for his information at any time of the debate, but not so ^{&c.,} as to interrupt a Member speaking.
