

place at the second sale of such Land or Lands as aforesaid.

XIV. Provided always and be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that if at the expiration of six months next after the date of such sale or sales of Land or Lands no *Opposition à fin de conserver*, to the whole or any part of the proceeds of such sale or sales, be filed in the Office of the Sheriff, in whose hands such moneys may be, such Sheriff shall on demand of the person or persons, who was or were the last proprietor or proprietors of such Land or Lands previous to the sale thereof as aforesaid, refund and pay to him or them the said proprietor or proprietors the whole of the moneys remaining in his hands, having therefrom previously deducted the amount of the assessments as aforesaid, (which he is hereby required to pay into the the hands of the Treasurer) and deducting also his own reasonable and necessary disbursements, and two and a half per cent. upon the whole amount of moneys by him as aforesaid levied.

XV. Provided always, and be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that nothing in this Act contained, shall in any wise extend to diminish, bar or extinguish any claim or real rights or servitude, claimed by any person or persons, to and upon such Land or Lands so as aforesaid liable, such person or persons filing their oppositions, whether the same be *à fin d'annuller*, or *à fin de distraire*, or *à fin de charge*, or *servitude*, within the time and in the manner as heretofore by Law provided, nor shall this Act be construed in any shape to alter the duties of the Sheriffs of the several Districts in this Province, with respect to such oppositions as already by Law it is provided.

XVI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the Grand-Voyer shall and he is hereby required to appoint for every Township within the District, some Inhabitant thereof, or in case there are no Inhabitants, some other person residing in some Parish or Township adjacent thereto, or some person being a proprietor in the said Township to be a Surveyor thereof, upon a request to him in writing to that effect, from any of the proprietors in such Township; and where the population of any Township is such that Overseers cannot be chosen and appointed in the manner as by Law already provided, it shall be lawful for the nearest Justice of the Peace, upon the request of the Grand-Voyer, and such Justice of the Peace is hereby ordered and required to nominate and appoint Overseers for the Township for which such Overseers may be required; such Overseers being either inhabitants or proprietors
