An Act to amend the Municipal Corporations Act of Upper Canada.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-Preamble. lative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

- 1. The Council of any incorporated village may pass by-laws for village Counraising money, by a rate to be assessed equally on the whole ratable cils may improperty of the village, for the relief and support of the resident poor rates. in the municipality.
- 2. The Council of any incorporated village may pass by-laws for May pass By-compelling persons to remove snow, ice, and dirt from the side-walks in laws for refront of the premises owned or occupied by them, and for removing the moval of same at the expense of the owner or occupant in case of default; and such last mentioned by-laws may be made to apply either to the whole of such village, or to certain streets or other localities therein, as the Council may think advisable for the public benefit.
 - 3. This Act shall apply only to Upper Canada.
