

WORLD'S LARGEST AEROPLANE AT WOLVERHAMPTON

Lientenant Seddon, an English Naval Officer, has constructed an Aeroplane at Dunstall, near Wolverhampton. The machine, which is twice as large as a Farman Biplane, and weighs about one ton, is propelled by two 80 horse-power engines, and its planes cover an area of 1,000 feet. The Lieutenant claims that his Biplane is the largest in the world. Our photographs show the curious hooplike structure which joins the framework.
