Sir-

Referring to your letter of the 14th Ultimo and to official letter to you of the 22nd Ultimo, I beg to say that the local Agent has reported to the Department that there are no improvements upon the land of the late Charles Anthony, on the Moravian Indian Reserve, and consequently you are entitled to no compensation as, having married out of the Band, your one and only claim could have been for compensation for improvements, having forfeited by such marriage all claim to share in the land. You will kindly consider this letter as the conclusion of the matter, so far as the Department is concerned.
