
Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 23rd ultimo, inclosing copy of Minutes passed by the Watha band, requesting permits for Daniel Commandant, Simon Rennie, Simon Laforce and Joseph Lafleche, I have to inform you that permits may be issued to them to cut on their respective locations, for sale, such quantities of burnt timber as you consider advisable, subject to reduced rate of dues as per tariff under sworn returns by each.

The cutting might be done under the supervision of Peter Stock.

The usual two acre limit may be assigned to Albert Commandant for clearing.
