Ottawa, 20th May, 1914.

Sirt-

I beg to confirm the following telegram sent you on the 17th instant, viz:-

• That Mr. [Name] appointed about twenty ten pay-
 • ment. That the [Name] is under separate report.
 • Also arrange with [Name] by [Name] for transportation
 • for party and purchase all necessary supplies for use of
 • party. Paying officer not appointed yet.

Mr. [Name] will be paid at the rate of \$ 200.00
 per month and his salary will commence from the date his
 services will be required by the Paying Officer before
 leaving, and will continue until completion of his work,
 after his return to [Name].

An allowance of ten or three days for preparation,
 before setting out, is made, and eight or ten days on return-
 ing to complete the pay check by [Name], under the [Name]
 to complete collection, reports, accounts, etc. is considered
 sufficient.

Last year the check was allowed from the 15th
 September to the 15th October for completion of this work,
 and yet he neglected to make a second copy of the pay check.
