We will have Mr. Robertsons men to be careful not to do any damage or cut any trees along the road. In having that amount we, of course, will be willing to pay more money than we paid last year.

We would consider this a great favour if you would make arrangements for us. Kindly let us know the price they would ask for the privilege of going across their roads.
