I have therefore to request that you go over such applications carefully and report in detail your views thereon to the Commission, accurately describing such alternative lands as you may see fit to recommend, assuring yourself that such lands are vacant and available; and indicating each of the same by a key letter or number on a map or plan, in order that each recommended parcel may be sufficiently located to permit of the identification thereof, for reservation by the Provincial Department of Lands.

I would further call your attention to the note in "Status of Land" column with respect to Item No. 9 and request you to ascertain the status of the land at the head of Rupert Arm to which you referred in your examination in connection with this particular application.

In re Item No. 24: I should be glad if you would advise the Commission whether, when you stated that you could not recommend the application inasmuch as the land covered thereby had been Crown Granted, you had or had not in mind merely the application for the large undefined area referred to by the Indians or also the small islands on which are certain Indian houses.

In respect to Item No. 28: I have to ask that you furnish the Commission with a sufficient description of the recommended area to permit of its positive identification for purposes of reservation.

I shall be glad to have you give early and careful attention to the several matters herein referred to, and report to the Commission..
