ORDER OF PROCEEDINGS

CONVENTIONS

- 1. At the hour of meeting the chair shall be taken, and the meeting called to order by the presiding officer.
- 2. The proceedings of each day shall be opened by prayer.
- 3. The report of the preceding Convention shall be submitted, the minutes of the preceding Session read, and the minutes of such Meetings of Executive Committee, as have been held since the last Session of the Convention, submitted, with Programme of Proceedings for the Session as prepared by the Executive Committee.
- 4. Regular business, as arranged by the Executive Committee.
 - 5. New business.
 - 6. Adjournment.
- 7. Fifteen members shall constitute a quorum at all meetings of the Association, and five those of its Committees.
- 8. No alteration shall be made in these By-Laws except by a two-thirds vote at an Annual Convention; but Rules of Order may be suspended for any Session, by a two-thirds vote at that Session.
