That the committee had again taken His Excellency's speech into consideration---And had come to the following resolution---to wit: Report of the committee.

*Resolved*, that it is the opinion of this committee “That a sum not exceeding be granted as an allowance in support of a Provincial Seminary of Learning”---

*Ordered*, that the said report be accepted.

House in committee---

Major *Hailes* in the chair---

Took into consideration the report of the committee appointed to examine the Treasurer's accounts, with the several papers accompanying the same. House in committee.

The *Speaker* resumed the chair---

The chairman *Reported*,---

That the committee had taken the said report and papers into their consideration and had come to the following resolution, to wit: Report of the committee.

“*Resolved*, that it is the opinion of this committee that the Treasurer be directed to call on Mr. *John Colvill* for the sum of *Four Pounds Five Shillings and Three Pence* for duties unpaid on *Forty* barrels of Wheat Flour and *six* barrels of Rye Flour imported in the Brig *Active* in the month of August 1790.” Resolve.

And that the committee had approved of the report of the select committee upon the Treasurer's accounts and recommended the same to be adopted and approved by the House—Which is as follows, to wit:
