

CHINESE GOLF LINKS

Grave Mounds Serve as Bunkers and Burials Take Place While Play Goes On.

The most gruesome golf links in the world are in Tientsin, China, where a course is laid out in an imnense graveyard.

"And it is a mighty good course too," declares Major Palmer E. Pierce, an American, who recently returned from two years' infantry service in China. "The grave mound serve as bunkers the course is pretty level all the way round and some
