

COUNTERFEITS.

The following simple rules, laid down by a bank note examiner, will be found of service in the detection of counterfeiters: First—Examine the form and features of all human figures.

Second—Examine the lettering. In a genuine bill it is absolutely perfect. There is never a counterfeit put out but was more or less defective in the lettering.

Third—Counterfeits rarely if ever get the imprint or engraver's name correct. The shading in the background of the vignette and over and around the letters forming the name of the bank on a good bill is even and perfect; on a counterfeit it is uneven and imperfect.

LEATHER NOVELTIES.

Rich reddish brown leather pocket-books are handsomely mounted in gold. A new finish in fine leathers, such as shown in catalogues and similar goods, includes a marbled effect in gray and in some other colors.
