GUELPH WRECK VERDICT.

Train Was Going Sixty Miles An Hour, "a Dangerous Rate."

Guelph, March 27.—The finding of the jury, empanelled to examine into the recent wreck on the G.T.R. near Guelph, shows that the train was going at the rate of sixty miles an hour, which they considered "a dangerous rate of speed, considering the season, the weight of the rail and the engine."

Rebel Defeated.

Willemstad, Island of Curacao, March 27.—A letter received here yesterday by the Venezuelan Consul from Caracas says that Gen. Juan Pablo Penabaz, who was reported early in the month to have started a serious rebellion in the State of Tachira, Venezuela, has been defeated; that he is being pursued by the Government troops, and that his capture is shortly expected.

Held for Robbery.
