MONTREAL STOCKS
STRIKE DULL TONEBonds the Only Firm Issue
Throughout Entire List
Friday.

MONTREAL, Nov. 4.—Trading on the local stock exchange today fell back to the indeterminate conditions of the early days of the week, with losses and gains about evenly divided and transactions totalling little more than one-third of yesterday's total.

National Breweries led the market, opening higher at 5 1/2% and then working down to 5 1/4%. The stock closed at 5 1/4%, a net loss of 1/4% for the day.

Announcement of changes in the company's directorate seems to have taken a good deal of the interest out of Atlantic Sugar, which opened at 25 1/2%, but advanced 3/4% point, though moderately heavy, left the stock a point down at the close of 3 1/4%.

The papers were generally quiet and easier. Brompton, leading the group, closed the list at 25 1/2%. The stock of the River common had unchanged, with the preferred 1/4 point lower at 7 1/4%. Howard-Smith preferred again showed marked strength, selling 3 1/2 points higher at 8 1/2%.

Loyal was one of the most active stocks in the list. It opened a point lower at 65, sold up to 66 1/2 and closed unchanged at 66. A fair interest was maintained in the interest out of Atlantic Sugar, which opened at 25 1/2% and advanced 3/4% point. Montreal Power gained 1/4 point, and Shawinigan sold a point higher at 105.

Some increases of activity were noted in bonds and prices were firm all through the list. An excellent market is reported for all bonds.

SEVERE SLUMP IN MARKS.
London, Nov. 4.—German marks today suffered the severest slump they have yet experienced in the London exchange market, being quoted during the noon hour at 95 to the pound sterling, after opening at 87 1/2.

The market was at a loss to account for the depreciation in the quotations, beyond the influences already known to be at work, and the fact that selling orders were heavy.

New York, Nov. 4.—German marks, which have been declining steadily here, dropped to a new low record today, selling at 43c. This was a drop of 2 points from yesterday's low. Weakness of German exchange in London accounted for the latest drop here.

The cash grain situation was about unchanged, the demand for the two top grades continued good, while No. 3 northern was not wanted. The premium was quoted at 3c over and a fair amount of business was transacted.

The coarse grains continued dull, but there is a good inquiry for the lower grades of oats, barley and rye, while the flax market was featureless.
