This Court has jurisdiction in Appeal from each of the three Courts of Queen's Bench, Chancery, and Common Pleas; and sits three times a year. Its regular times of sitting are at the City of Toronto, on the second Thursday after each Term, except Trinity Term. The Chief Justice of the Court of Queen's Bench for the time being, and, in his absence, the Judge of the said Court, entitled to precedence over all the Judges actually present, presides; and seven Members of the Court are necessary to constitute a quorum.
