WACHORN'S CUIDE.

No person enail at any time offer for sale, barter or exchange, any Prairie Chicken that has been, caught or, killed by any person other than himself.

Non-residents of the N. W. T. require a license from the Commissioner of Agriculture at Regina (fee \$15) to built or shoot. Licenaes cover period from Aug. 1 to Dec. 31 annually, but do not give right to built or shoot until the expiration of two weeks after protected animals or birds may lawfully be hunted or killed by residents of the Territories.

The possession of any dead animals, or birds, or parts (except skins lawfully taken), is prohibited during Close Season. But any animal or bird lawfully taken at other times can be bought or sold. Game guardians can sleep birds or animals, illegally in possession

and bring offenders before a Justice of the Peace within 3 months

eroffense. Fine—Buffalo \$100; other game \$50 or 2 months.

The export or carrying out of the N. W. T. of Grouse, Pattridge,
Pheasant, Prairie Chichen, Elk, Mosse, Carlboo, Autelope, or their Fawn; is prohibited.

Lime, chemicals, offal, sawdust, or any deleterious substances prohibited in waters. The use of explosives, spears, dire arms, &c., illegal. Special licenses to Indians for food fishing. Note must be raised and all fishing stopped between 6 p.in. on Sainrieva and 6 s. m. on Mondane.
