- DRITISH COLUMBIA LETTER.

(Quintipondence of the Canada Lumbermani)

VANCOUVER, April 13th, 1904.-Lumbermen are joyous this week, sa the most glorious of summer-weather has burst upon the coast, and operations in the woods will soon be begun. Winter has hung on ng, in fact so much so in the interior that it is believed there will be a shortage in the supply of lumber required, for use in the Territories and Manitoba. In Fernie and other of the towns on the eastern boundary the frost is still delaying things, and a number of the mills have not yet started. At present there is only about 10,000,000 feetioflimber cut in the whole of the interior, but when spring operations begin, things should be active. The Fernic Lumber Company and the Crow's Nest Pass lumber Company seach has 6,000,000 feet of logs ready, and there are 29 or 30

miles in the Kootesays, some of them of large capacity.

Conditions are firm this week, prices remaining the same as two weeks ago, with all kinds of building materials in good demand.

Although an announcement was made by the C. P. R. that a reduction in the fraight rate on lumber to the Territories was to be put into effect, it was semewhat mis-"levillage" Hitherto the shipments from the coast were subject to a tariff of 40 cents per hundred pounds upon it striker, and upon codar and other lumber so could per too pounds. The tariff has now been changed upon cedar and other lumber to 40 cents per 100, poinds upon dimension and the lower grades up to that of shiplap, being the same rate as that of fir, but upon grades of cedar and other lumber better than the ship-lap grade the former

rite of so cents per 100, pounds: colitinues in force. The coast manufacturers and those in the Kootenay are coming into competition, for the reduction in prices succed by the mill men on the coast on ship-lap and the common grades of jumber, which will compete with the white pine and aprace lumber saws in the interior. The Mountain manufacturers were offered, a reduction of two cents per 100 pounds between Swift Current and Broadview, if they would reduce the price of lumber \$1 per thousand feet to all customers east of McLeod. The proposal was declined by the lumbermen, who agreed to reduce the price as requested if the 'C. P. R. would reduce its rates two cents over the whole of the territory east of Mc-Leod. There the matter stands at present.

It is reported that Loveland & Stone, of Cutler, Ont., have sold the entire output

of their mill for the coming season, what is estimated at 30,000,000 feet.
