Another action has been begun at Toronto by dissatisfied shareholders against the directors of the Canada Cycle Co. The object is to establish the assertion that the purchase of the National Cycle Co. and its absorption into the trust was illegal, and that the directors of the Canada Cycle Co. are personally responsible for the loss that followed the acquisition of the National Cycle Co. W. W. Bedwell, on behalf of himself and all other stockholders, and J. W. Flavel, Hon. J. A. Cox, A. E. Ames, W. Y. Soper, Mrs. Susie Massey, Chester Master and J. H. Houser for the cancellation of the agreement under which the National was taken over for the return to the Canada Cycle Co.'s treasury of \$280,000, the purchase price of \$150,000 paid out for National Cycle Co. debts and \$75,000 interest on Cycle preferred stock, paid when it had not been earned.
