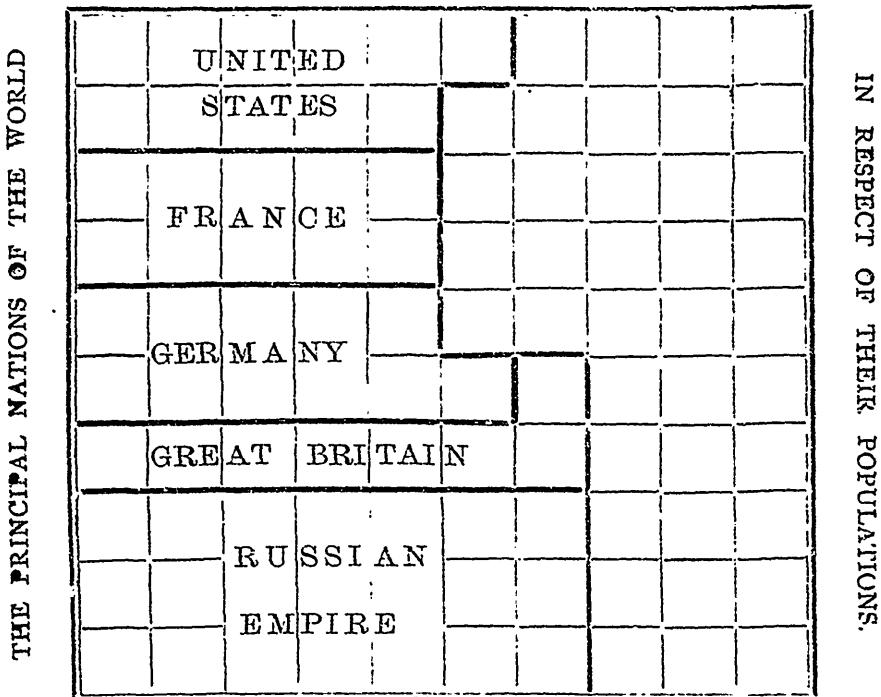

*Compared with China*



**T**HE ABOVE DIAGRAM presents to the eye the facts concerning the populations of five great nations compared with the population of China. Each of the small squares represents four millions of souls. One hundred of these, therefore, or the whole number embraced in the diagram, may stand for China. On this surface the United States takes, approximately, eleven squares; France, ten; Germany, eleven; Great Britain, eight; and Russia, twenty-one. The aggregate population of these five nations equals only sixty-one one hundredths of the number of souls in the Chinese Empire.
