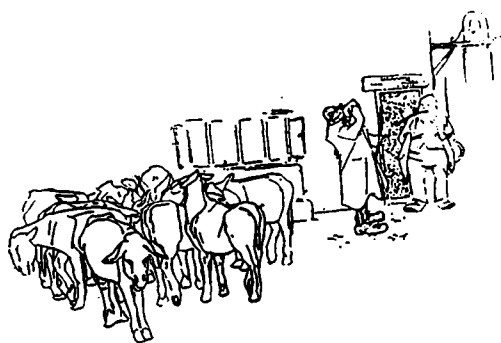
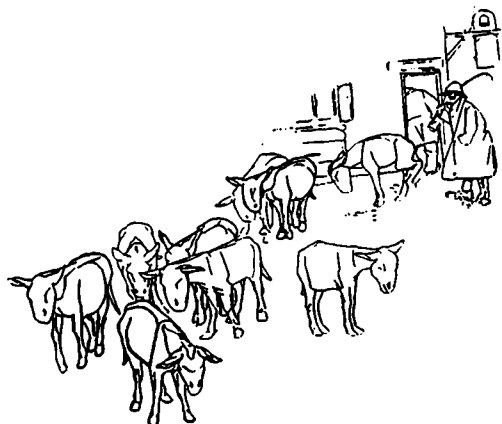


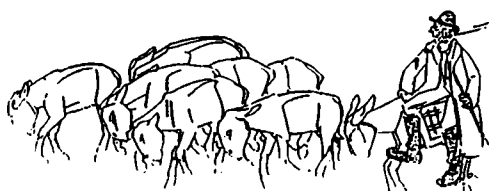
The Countryman and His Asses



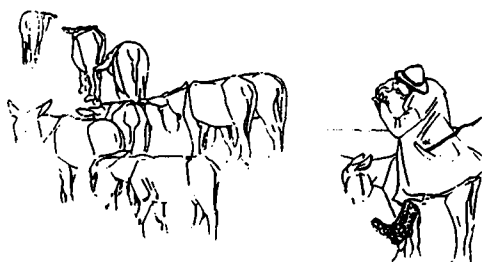
1.—A countryman had been to market with his corn—

5.—And so kept telling them over and over again—



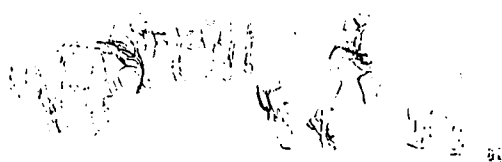
6.—Fore and aft, left and right—



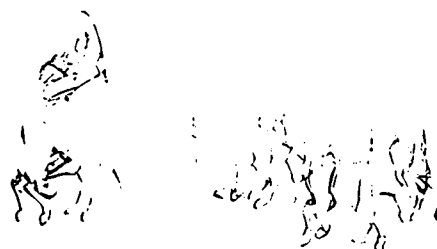
7.—But still wanted one of his number—
