

10. Implementing arrangements between the Federal Ministry of Defence on the part of the Federal Republic of Germany and the Department of National Defence on behalf of Canada may be made for the purpose of carrying out the intent of this Agreement.

11. Either Government may, if obliged to do so for extraordinary reasons, suspend in whole or in part the training conducted at Goose Bay. In the event of such suspension, the financial consequences resulting therefrom shall be settled in separate negotiations.

12. This Agreement, which provides for a trial exercise evaluation period shall remain in force until December 31, 1980.

If the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany, I have the honour to propose that this Note which is authentic in English and French, and your Excellency's Note in reply thereto, which is authentic in German, shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments, which shall enter into force on the date of your Excellency's reply.
