Dear Mr. Minister:

I am pleased to inform you that my Government concurs in the suggestion conveyed in your letter of October 23, 1958 that the arrangements first made in 1942 for the exchange of agricultural workers be extended to cover woods workers as well.

My Government also accepts the suggestion that your letter and this reply be considered an agreement to extend until the end of 1958 the arrangements in question and that the necessary details be arranged between the Canadian and United States officials directly concerned.
