BUDGET:-

RECOMMENDATIONS:-

Although there are as yet no School Library Standards the development of school libraries is of growing importance in the West. It would seem that some training for teacher-librarians is the type most needed at present. If any further library training is to be given at the University of British Columbia, it is suggested that this need be satisfied. As the the one year library schools already supply the demand for trained librarians in British Columbia, it would not seem immediately necessary to establish a permanent Library School there.
