

ABSTRACT OF PROCEEDINGS OF CENTRAL BOARD, 1866.

JANUARY.

Ordered, that \$631.20 received from sale of land in the township of Halifax, be added to the Sustentation Fund. Annual Report adopted and ordered to be presented to the Society.

Mr. G. Hall appointed Auditor.

\$50 additional granted to each of the seven Madowment Funds created last year.

Committee appointed to solicit subscriptions to the Society from all Churchmen in Quebec and its environs.

Standing Committees appointed.

FEBRUARY.

Ordered, that the Bank Stock forming the investment of the Mission Fund, be transferred to the Bishop and his successors in trust for the Diocesan Board.

MARCH.

The Treasurer instructed to invest in some safe security other than Bank Stock, the amount at credit of the Widows' and Orphans' Fund. Ordered that a new edition of 2,000 copies of the tract, "What is the Church Society" be published, and that the Rev. C. Hamilton be requested to undertake the revision and issue of it.

APRIL.

Travelling Missionary appointed to the charge of the Quarantine Station.

Committee appointed in January last to solicit subscriptions, discharged, and another appointed.

SEPTEMBER.

Granted, such sum as will enable the Education Committee to assist the Schools aided by the Society, on the conditions specified in the Report.
