*N. B. When subscriptions are sent to the office an additional charge is made to prepay on the Chromos. The stretcher mounted can be sent only by express, at subscriber's expense, which on *direct* lines is 75 cents. A large saving is therefore made by subscribing through the agent. New York City and Canadian subscribers must, however, pay 20 cents additional to cover American postage, which we are obliged to prepay. You will observe that this table is compiled for all our United States readers without reference to the special disadvantage under which you labor, viz., double postage, express charge and duties, but which we now hope to remove as much as possible by this our special tariff. We will only charge you the postage and express charges, and we pay the Canadian duties out of the exchange in the currency.

We have, therefore, concluded for the present to offer our publication to you free of charge (except the Canadian postage on the paper, which you are required to pay at your own post-office), at the following prices in Canada Funds or Gold :—
